## **Environmental Objectives 2024**

- 3. Reduce our overall waste to landfill by 5 percent over a 2-year period;
- 4. Actively promote and engender environmental awareness among our workforce; targeting remote field teams or individuals through improved open communication and dialogue; and
- 5. Offset our carbon emissions through a volunteer community tree planting scheme; engaging up to 70 percent of our workforce to remove 2500 to 5000kg of carbon dioxide from the atmosphere over a 1-year period.
